Notes on Sterling Gift Aid Pledge:

- (1) Please notify the Diocese in Europe if you change your name or address while the pledge is still in force. You can cancel the pledge at any time by notifying the Diocese in Europe – it will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify
- (2) You must pay an amount of UK income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the Diocese in Europe reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).
- (3) If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay UK tax on your income/capital gains equal to the tax that the Diocese in Europe reclaims, you can cancel your pledge (see note 1)
- (4) If you pay at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
- (5) If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the Diocese in Europe. Or you can ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 Gift Aid.
